This week we have been discussing why having 'good manners' is important and we are really encouraging our children to use 'good manners' in the dinner hall. We have also noticed that lots of our younger children are struggling to use a knife and fork whilst eating their dinner – so please model and encourage this at home.

Table Manners

- Use your knife and fork at all times.
- Don't throw food.
- Eat with your mouth closed.
- Don't speak with your mouth full.
- Don't make a mess.
- No tipping or spilling.
- Don't use your fingers to eat.
- Ask to be excused if you want to leave.
- Don't kick under the table.
- No toys at the table.

What do you need to know?

It runs daily in the hall

It starts at 8:00am

You can **pay as you go** by cash on the day or by Parent Pay

Cost for one child is £2 a day

If you have 2 children it is £3 a day in total

If you have 3 children it is £5 a day in total

There is a choice of toast or cereal and a drink of milk or juice which our Catering Team prepare

The club is well attended and children enjoy a wide range of activities in a nurturing environment under the supervision and guidance of our committed staff

Please remember to send your child's reading book bag in everyday and remember to listen to them read/ or share a story...
