<p>Spring 1 Topic: Jesus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The stories of Jesus' miracles are found in the Gospels in the New Testament. Christians believe that the miracles reveal Jesus as the Son of God. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Retell the stories about Jesus covered in this unit. Talk about my own experiences and feelings.
<p>Spring 2 Topic: Easter</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The events of Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Day are very important. Christians believe that Easter is a new beginning. Christians believe that Jesus died and rose back to life again. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recall about the events of the Easter story. Retell the story of Easter.
<p>Summer 1 Topic: Baptism</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Baptism is an occasion when Christians make promises to God and people are welcomed as a member of the church. Water is a symbol of baptism. People can be baptised at any age. Jesus was baptised in the river Jordan by John the Baptist. People of world faiths welcome new babies in special ways. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about what belonging means to me. Use religious vocabulary such as vicar, priest, font, baptism church and prayer. Talk about what happens when a baby is baptised.
