<p style="text-align: center;">Spring 1 Topic: The Exodus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Exodus is a significant event in Jewish and Christian history. • The Seder is the special meal celebrated by Jews on the first evening of the festival of Passover • Christianity is rooted in Judaism and Jesus celebrated the Passover. • For Jews, the event of the Exodus and Passover are at the very heart of their beliefs. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Retell the Exodus story highlighting the connections to the Seder meal. • Make links between the Passover, Last Supper and the Eucharist. • Tell you why Passover is a festival of memory and freedom. • Express my opinions about freedom, what it is and what it is not. • Tell you about the similarities and differences between the importance placed on the Passover by Jews and Christians. • Explain why the Passover is not forgotten.
