Topic 1 Harvest. We will learn that the food we eat comes from all around the world, that not everyone in the world enjoys a good harvest, about Christian charities that are helping people who live in poor countries, that Christians believe it is good to say thank you to God for the harvest and that the Jewish festival of harvest is called Sukkot.

Key Vocabulary:

Harvest- when crops such as vegetables and fruits are ripe and are taken from the plants on which they grow

Harvest Festival- a Christian celebration when Christians thank God for the Harvest

Topic 2 My World, Jesus' World We will find out that Jesus lived a long time ago in a world very different to ours, Christians believe that Jesus is the Son of God, Christians believe that Jesus understands what it is like to live an everyday life as a human being.

Key Vocabulary:

Jesus- the teacher and prophet who founded the Christian faith. He is considered by Christians to be the son of God and the Christ or saviour. Jesus lived from about 4 B.C. to 29 A.D.

Jerusalem- a city in modern-day Israel. Jesus visited Jerusalem as a young child with his parents.

Nazareth- a city in modern-day Israel. Jesus lived in Nazareth with his parents.

Topic 3 Christmas We will learn that the wise men visited Jesus after the shepherds and that Christians believe that Jesus is a gift from God.

Key Vocabulary:

Gift something a person gives without wanting anything in return

Magi- according to the New Testament, the three wise men from the East who followed a brilliant star to find the infant Jesus Christ and honour him with gifts

Promise- a statement that something absolutely will happen or be done.
