<p><b>*English/History</b> Complete the Viking "Mash-Cam" 2Do on Purple Mash and write in role as a Viking, explaining your everyday life. What do you do all day? How do you do it? What do the rest of your family do?</p>	<p><b>*MATHS</b> Measure 5 items in your bedroom, e.g. a drawer unit, your bed, a storage box etc. Record the length, width and height of the objects in cm. Convert the measures to mm and then m. Choose one of the items and calculate its volume, showing your working.</p>	<p><b>ENGLISH</b> Write a character portrait for an imaginary character.</p>
<p><b>English/PSHE</b> Write a letter to your future self, writing about what you would like to have achieved by the end of Year 6. Will you have your "Pen Licence"? Will you be able to swim?</p>	<p><b>*HISTORY/DT/Art</b> Research Viking long ships and then: Draw a diagram and label the features of a Viking long-ship OR Make a 3d model of a Viking long ship.</p>	<p><b>History/Art</b> Find out about Viking runes and then use your knowledge to create a decorative name label in Viking runes! (You could also write a secret message!)</p>
